
Flowers



Flowers are ideal for someone whose space has mostly artifical light and is rather humid.

- 1. Water once or twice a week.
- 2. *Choose* a place with decent natural light as they need at least an hour of sun a day.
- 3. *Prune* the plant by cutting off each dry or faded bloom.

Succulents





- 1. Water when the soil is dry.
- 2. *Choose* a spot with lots of direct sun as this plant requires 6 hours of light a day.
- 3. *Clean* the dust from the stem and branches.

Ferns



Ferns thirve in a bright environment and also with lots of water.

- 1. Water a little everyday to keep the soil moist.
- 2. *Choose* a spot with indirect rather than direct sunlight that the plant can sit in all day.
- 3. *Prune* by removing the dead parts of the fern.

Vines



Vines love sunlight and need to be placed in a sunny room. They do not require much water though.

- 1. Water when the top 3 inches of soil is dry.
- 2. *Choose* a spot with lots of sun as it will need at least 6 hours of light a day.
- 3. *Prune* the plant each spring to promote growth.
